



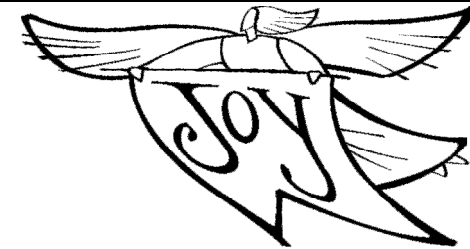

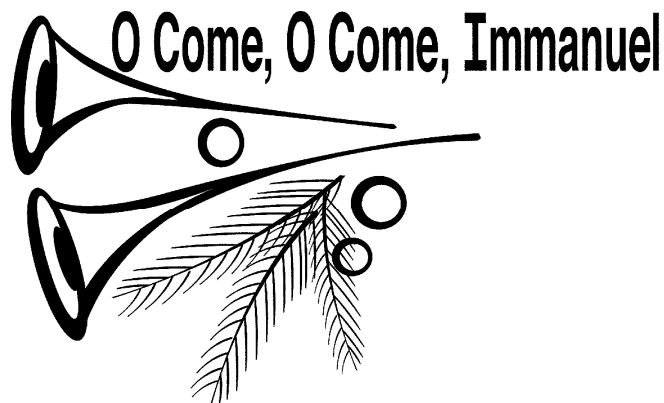

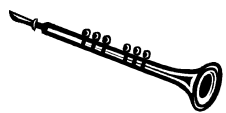
Visitors We extend to you a special welcome and invite you to join us after the service for visiting and refreshments. Please sign our Guest Book located on the lectern in the sanctuary.
